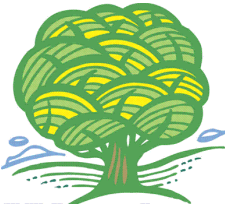
June 25th – At 6:30 PM Ordination to the Diaconate of Barbara Geer Talcott here at St. Paul's Church. All are invited to attend this celebration.

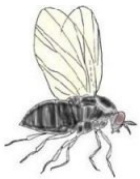

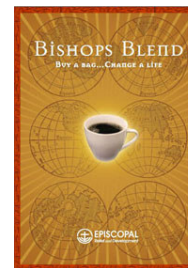
